Statement for Determining Test Preparation of formally admitted candidates

TEA Rule (19 TAC 228.40(d)) “The EPP has a process for determining that formally admitted candidates are prepared to take certification examinations.”

The University of Dallas, Educator Preparation Program (EPP) requires candidates to pass the practice content and PPR exams administered by Certify Teacher before they are granted approval for the TExES content or PPR test. The candidates are required to take the test once through exam mode. If they do not pass then they must complete and pass the study guide section before taking the exam a second time. Once a student passes the practice exam through Certify Teacher, they must contact the Certification Officer for approval for TExES testing. Certify Teacher will also be used as a tool in remediation of candidates who do not successfully complete their TExES content or PPR test.
